**Lyon L-91.0166**, Thailand: Surath Vanno, via R. Hirano, as *Kaempferia* sp.; **same as L-86.702**. In flower, 15 Jan 99. Voucher: AN 009 -HLA(2): Plant to 15 cm tall. Lamina medium to dark green, ridged on upper surface, violet below; petiole violet. Inflorescence basal; bracts red-violet. Flowers white, with light yellow blotch on lowermost petal.

**L-91.0331**, Thailand: Kampon Tansacha, via Betty Ho, as *Kaempferia* sp. To J. Kress 94-5326 – US (includes living & voucher).

**L-92.0232**, Australia: Alan Carle, (has its own page).

**L-92.0413**, Florida: Jack Craig, via D. Henkle. 1 planted 5 Sep 1997, **upper H22, above middle bend of trail, between 2 *Sommieria***.

**Lyon L-86.0702**, Thailand: W. Sumawong 111204, as *Aglaonema* sp. #4; **same as L-91.166**. To W.J. Kress.

Voucher: KMN 3784 –HLA. Herb 15-25 cm ht.; sterile shoots with 2-4 leaves, fertile shoots with 1 leaf. Leaves coriaceous, narrowly elliptic-ovate, dark green with faint silvery marking on either side of midrib on upper surface, maroon beneath, 11-18 x 4.5-7 cm. Infl. terminal, 3 x 2 cm; peduncle maroon, 3.5 cm; bract maroon, 2 cm, slightly deflexed; bracteole maroon, 2 cm. Calyx 10 mm, with maroon streaks, cleft on one side; floral tube 3.5 cm, ampliate at apex, slightly lilac; corolla lobes white to pale lilac, 15-20 mm; lateral staminodes white or pale yellow, 20 x 7 mm; labellum white with pale yellow center with distinct translucent longitudinal veins, bilobed, 25 x 21 mm; filament maroon, 2 mm, anther 4 mm.

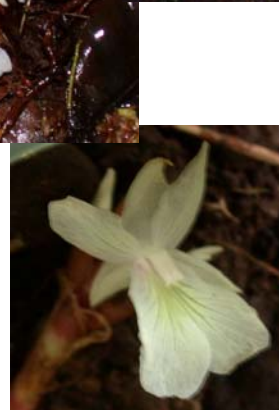
