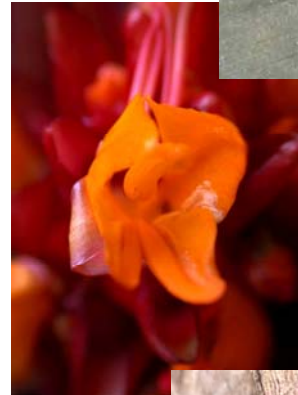

Lyon L-95.0435, as *C. sp.*, Viet Nam: coll. by Mark Collins VN 8077. In flower, Aug-Sep 96. Voucher: AN 034 – HLA. Herb up to 0.3 m tall; stem base pink shading to violet brown shading to green. Leaf petiolate, lanceolate, ridged, dark green & glabrous above, lighter green & velvety below, with slug or insect damage. Peduncle pink. Flower bracts whitish at base shading to maroon at apex. Sepals peachy red; petals tangerine orange, each with maroon spot near midvein at the level where petals join lip; lip bifurcate, outer parts yellow-orange, center tangerine red, red line separates outer and center parts; maroon suffusion in cream-colored throat.

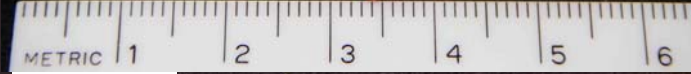
