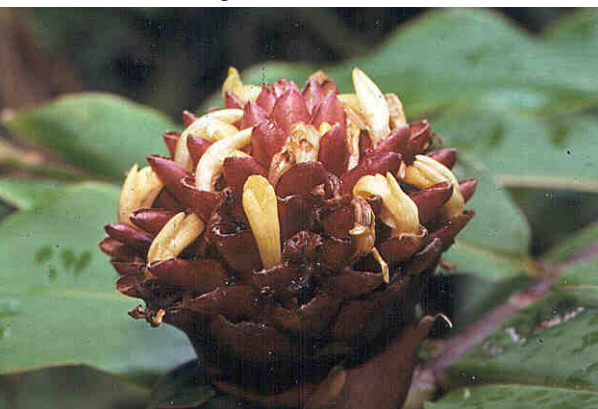


Alpinia pinetorum Loes. (*Alpinia* Section *Dieramalpinia*)

All accessions coll. by R. Hirano, as *Alpinia* sp.; ID as *A. paradoxa* by J. Mood, 18 Jul 1999. J. Mood says type specimen of *Adelmeria* is at Singapore. Re-ID by as *A. pinetorum*, based on its acute labellum (*A. bifida* [*paradoxa*?] has a bifid lip), and is found near Bagio at 5000' elev. in pine forests, fide telephone conversation with J. Mood, 16 Jan 2000. All planted in H30, Sept 1988 - Apr 1989.

L-87.0646 (#11) (shown above), planted 5' mauka/ewa of H30-24-5 *Wallaceodendron*. ID confirmed by H. Funakoshi, July 2002.

Same as the following: **L-87.0607** (#3), planted 8' ewa of H30-25-3 *Myrciaria*. Voucher: AN 047 - HLA (2).

L-87.0609 (#2), planted c.20' ewa of H30-25-3 *Myrciaria*, w/ purple ti.

L-87.0630 (#6) - Banaue, planted makai of H30-23-1, ewa/mauka corner of three kinds of ginger.

L-87.0634 (#7), planted 10-20' below H30-23-4 *Elaeocarpus*; to A. Carle.

L-87.0644 (#9) - Banaue, planted far makai of H30-23-1, makai-most of triangle of 3 kinds of ginger.

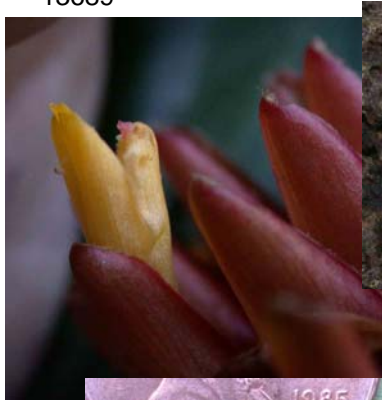
